## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What does an alignment cost?

All alignment work is by the hour. In general, a precision alignment to factory specifications on an unmodified car take will take less than 2 hours. A performance alignment can take over 4 hours depending on the options selected such as corner weights and bump steer.

### What is the cost of parts needed for a job?

We are happy to get the parts for you. The cost is our cost plus 20% for procurement. We are happy to use parts that you provide.

### What will a job cost?

We will provide an estimate after inspection. We will not exceed the estimate without your prior permission. Inspections are billed at flat rate labor price and can generally be done in 1/2 hour.
